A Regular Meeting of the El Paso City Council was called to order by Mayor Price on March 18, 2019 at 7:30 PM.

Council Members Present: Kearney, Faulk, Wheatley and Kilpatrick. Absent: Moore and Brucker

Also present: Attorney Stoller, Treasurer Linda Haas, Chief Dave Duncan, Casey Jones, Colton Scott, Becky Carter and Kim Kearney as the local press.

Pledge of allegiance to the flag was recited.

Approval of Agenda: Motion by Kearney, seconded by Kilpatrick to approve agenda as presented. Voice vote taken of all ayes.

Council Minutes: The minutes of the March 4, 2019 Regular City Council Meeting were presented in written form.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report for the month ending February 28, 2019 showing investments, revenue and expenses were presented in written form.

Register of Bills: The Register of Bills in the amount of \$61,087.82 was presented.

Work Session Minutes: The minutes of the March 7, 2019 City Council Work Session were presented in written form.

Approval of Consent Agenda: Motion by Kearney, seconded by Kilpatrick to approve items on consent agenda as presented. Voice vote taken of all ayes.

Recycling: Current issues about our recycling program were discussed. The decision was made that we will be discounting accepting glass when current container is filled.

Peddlers Permit: A sample policy was presented and modifications will be made and presented at our April 1st meeting. Attorney Stoller will draft an ordinance after policy is accepted.

Yard Waste: A policy concerning yard waste was presented. Motion by Kearney, seconded by Wheatley to approve policy as presented. Voice vote taken of ayes.

Nuisance Animal Trapping: Skunks and traps were discussed and with Vergil off we have no one available to set and empty traps. If any calls or persons come in we are to inform that there is a gentleman in Eureka who offers this service.

2019-2020 Capital Budget Discussion: An updated draft of proposed Capital Equipment and Projects will be available at our April 1st meeting.

Director of Public Service: Jack reports that work continues on sewer lift station issues, trees to cut down, pumping out of the pool, work on ball fields, and HVAC work at community room is about done.

Mayor's Report: The Mayor spoke briefly about the County Revolving Loan Fund and ADA projects being discussed.

City Council Comments: None.

Staff Reports: Alderwoman Kilpatrick complimented Recreation Department on the brochure that was mail to all addresses in Secor, El Paso and Gridley.
