April 1, 2019

A Regular Meeting of the El Paso City Council was called to order by Mayor JW Price on April 1, 2019 at 7:30 PM.

Proposed Budget Discussion: Clerk Fever passed out listing and presented actual expenses for FY 2019 and proposals for FY 2020 for Capital Equipment and Capital Projects Funds. A work session is planned for Monday, April 8th at 7:00 PM for discussion of proposed FY 2020 budget.

Director of Public Service: Jack spoke about the pool and hopefully Wednesday the 10th the drain covers will installed and inspection to be scheduled after that.

Mayor's Report: The Mayor reported a notice has been received that a Grant may soon have funding of which we submitted for last September and will complete necessary documentation now needed.
