A Regular Meeting of the El Paso City Council was called to order by Mayor Price on June 4, 2018 at 7:30 PM.

Council Minutes: The minutes of the May 21, 2018 City Council Meeting were presented in written form.

Public Comments: Becky Carter asked about tree stump removal and was told after trees removed this summer we will be renting equipment for removal of all stumps cut in the last two years.

El Paso Fire Department-Fill the Boot: Motion by Steffen, seconded by Rigsby to grant permission to collect at of Routes 24 and 251 on Saturday on June 9, 2018. Roll call vote taken of all ayes.

Heartland Cable, Heartland Communications Representative: She announced an Informational Presentation to be held Thursday, June 21st at Community Building. She also said it will be about another 1½ years to complete the fiber installation.

Director of Public Service: Jack gave a summary of Memorial Day weekend including revenue and expenditures and Fill The Park will be continued next year with more advertising. Work has began on Jefferson Street Storm Sewer in the 100 block, He mowed the Ice pond area ditches

today. A water leak today on Front Street in front Burster's Inn was repaired but the water service line was incorrect material and replaced.

Hydrant flushing is completed and we will replacing about 8 more hydrants. Flow testing will be done later this summer.

Mayor's Report: The Mayor spoke also of Memorial Day weekend that it will be the first weekend in June next year with the street dance on Saturday
