A meeting of the Parks and Recreation Committee was held Monday July 24th, 2017 at the El Paso City Hall at 6:00 PM.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00.

Joe Harlan presented a packet of information that outlined the basic financial status of the Olympian Swim Team. Discussion was held about the cost to the City and the need to evaluate the services provided to the Swim team V/S the cost to the City. One item noted was that individuals that participate in Swim team or Swim lessons are not currently required to have a pool pass. No decisions were made on Fee changes for the Swim Team, however the subject will be discussed in future meetings. The Committee also agreed with the Swim team to allow the West walk in gate to be open during practice time.

It was noted that there is a place where kids can push through the fence and get in for free. That will be taken care of in the next few days.

The Committee wants to know the current status of the surveillance camera system at the pool. That will be checked on the next week.

Tree removal and replanting was discussed. Members were asked to evaluate what types of trees we should replant.

Derrick will coordinate a Parents night out event which will allow Parents to drop kids off at the Pool for an evening. The Parents can then go out while the kids are supervised at the pool for a couple of hours. National night out preparedness was discussed. Needs added to Facebook.

Hickok will complete Job posting and run add in the local paper as soon as possible.
