

City of El Paso Parks and Recreation Committee Minutes

The El Paso Parks and Recreation Committee met on Monday, December 21st, 2020 at the South Pointe Community Building. The meeting was called to order at 6:35 PM.

Members present were Mary Ellen Kilpatrick, Alex Brucker, and Jennifer Staulcup.

Present in person were Jeanne Kearney, Brandon Barker, Will Moore, Casey Jones, Colton Scott, and Barry Kauther.

The items listed on the agenda were discussion of up grades to the floor for South Pointe Park City Pool House and plans for the parks.

Director of Parks and Recreation had a discussion on the upgrades to the pool house. He advised that in the locker rooms new dividers, sinks, toilet, and the walls will be painted. With the new dividers and removal of toilets he will be able to meet ADA compliance. He added that since this work is being done it would make sense to refinish the floors at this time. Currently the floors are cover with plastic mats that are hard to keep clean. He looked into the refinishing the floors and had two estimates for the committee to consider.

- 1) Swanson Concrete - Price includes the following: Deep clean and grinding of entire surface to prepare for epoxy coating. Crack and surface repair. Application of base coat with flake (colors of choice). Application of clear coat. Comes with a 2-year warranty on the epoxy coating. Cost - \$9,945.00
- 2) Concrete Magic – Price includes the following: Concrete preparation, apply concrete penetrating bond coating, base coating with broadcast flake and seal coating. Graniflex comes with a limited lifetime warranty. This coating is flexible and will be easy to walk on while barefoot. Cost \$13,091.06.

Both estimates are discounted if they are applied during the off season. Samples of both flooring products were passed around for committee members to inspect.

After a short conversation Alex Brucker made a motion to recommend Concrete Magic to refinish the locker room floors at the pool house. The motion was seconded by Jennifer Staulcup. All present member voted Aye to approve the motion.

After the vote further discussion took place on the future plans for the parks and recreation. No further recommendations were made.

The meeting adjourned with a motion from Mary Ellen Kilpatrick at 7:17 PM and seconded by Alex Brucker. All present members voted Aye to approve the motion.
