Regular Meeting Minutes
June 15, 2015

A regular meeting of the El Paso City Council was called to order by Mayor Mool on June 15, 2015 at 7:30 PM.

Council Members Present: Benedict, Steffen, Roberts, Burton, Price and Brucker.

Also Present: Attorney Stoller, Karen Tallman, Gene Heller, Chief Price, Officer Clark, Casey Jones, Parks and Recreation Director Martin, Utilities Director Arbuckle, Jason Tindall, Jennie Kearney, and about 50 plus other persons.

Pledge of allegiance to the flag was recited.

Approval of Agenda: Attorney Stoller spoke of 7A on the agenda as not being specific enough per the open meetings act. The council wanted to discuss but not take action. Motioned by Price, seconded by Brucker to discuss item 7A but not vote .Roll call taken of all ayes.

Consent Agenda:

City Council Minutes: The minutes of the June 1, 2015 City Council Meeting were presented in written form.

Register of Bills: The Register of Bills for June 2015 was presented in the amount of \$90,337.23.

Approval of consent agenda: Motion by Burton, seconded by Price to approve items on consent agenda minus the Treasurer's Report as there was none. Roll call taken of all ayes.

Public Comments: Numerous people spoke about item 7A the non-binding agreement. There were about 6 persons from El Paso that spoke about the agreement.

Staff Reports:

He handed out fliers regarding the proposal between the school and the city to have more hours for the public at the fitness center.

Utilities Director: Chuck reported they are fighting the rain and the lift station going good.

City Clerk: Absent.

City Attorney: American Buildings acquired land and need to annex to the city and Beck's need a variance. Both companies want Jim to prepare information for the city.
