Regular Meeting Minutes
June 19, 2023

A Regular Meeting of the El Paso City Council was called to order by Mayor Price on June 19, 2023 at 7:00 PM.

Council Members Present: Kilpatrick, Ragusa, Moore and Howard. Absent: Mool and Brucker. Late: None. It was reported the meeting is being recorded.

Present in Person: Director of Public Services Barry Kauther, Attorney Jim Stoller, Clerk David Fever, Police Chief Joe Montemurro and Treasurer Linda Haas. Also present: Kim Kearney and Jennie Kearney as the local press.

Approval of Agenda: Corrected proposed Ordinance as 1064. Motion by Kilpatrick, seconded by Ragusa to approve the agenda as presented. Voice vote taken of all ayes.

July 3, 2023 Bills Payable: Motion by Moore, seconded by Ragusa to pre-approve payment of City bills as of July 3, 2023, since the next Council Meeting is not until July 17th. Voice vote taken of all ayes.

Director of Public Service: Report was presented in written form. He also reported that 88 golf cart tags have been issued in 2023 and for Council Members to contact him soon about reservations for IML Conference in September.

Mayor's Report: The Mayor commented that the new parking lot west across road at Recreation Building is now open.

City Council Comments: Howard spoke of power grid issues in South Africa and are we prepared against such in our Community.

Police Chief Report: The Chief's report was given in written form. He reported last month was very busy and plans are underway for National Night Out on August 1st.

Parks and Recreation Department: Colton was absent and unavailable..

Clerk's Report: The Clerk reported Sales Tax for March was up with percents to be reported next month.
