Zoning Board Meeting

The City of El Paso Zoning Board Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chris Gentes.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call was taken with members Nancy Johnson, Maureen Drake, Renee Donaldson and Ken Faulk present. Absent was Mary Wilkey.

Others present were: Director of Public Service, Barry Kauther; Council Member, Mary Ellen Kilpatrick; Kim Kearney, and Skip Harmon in person.

Also present via Zoom was Administrative Assistant, Sandee Kessinger and Council Member, Thad Mool.

Discussion was on a variance request for Trinity Lutheran Church Preschool for a four-foot chain link fence to be installed ten feet north of the property line towards 4th St. A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Drake to not recommend granting the variance. The Board did not feel that it was safe allowing children to be that close to the road with or without a fence. A voice vote was taken of all ayes with Donaldson abstaining due to being a member of the Church.

Discussion was on a variance request for McGrath Highway Chevrolet to install a 140-foot flag poll with a 30 by 60-foot flag (1800 square feet). Skip Harmon stated that they will be putting up an American Flag and he is a veteran and will be observing the Governors orders of half mast and etc. A motion was made by Drake and seconded by Gentes to recommend that the Council grants the requested variance. A voice vote was taken of all ayes.

A motion was made by Donaldson and Johnson seconded to adjourn the meeting. A voice vote was taken of all ayes. The meeting was adjourned at 6:25 PM.
